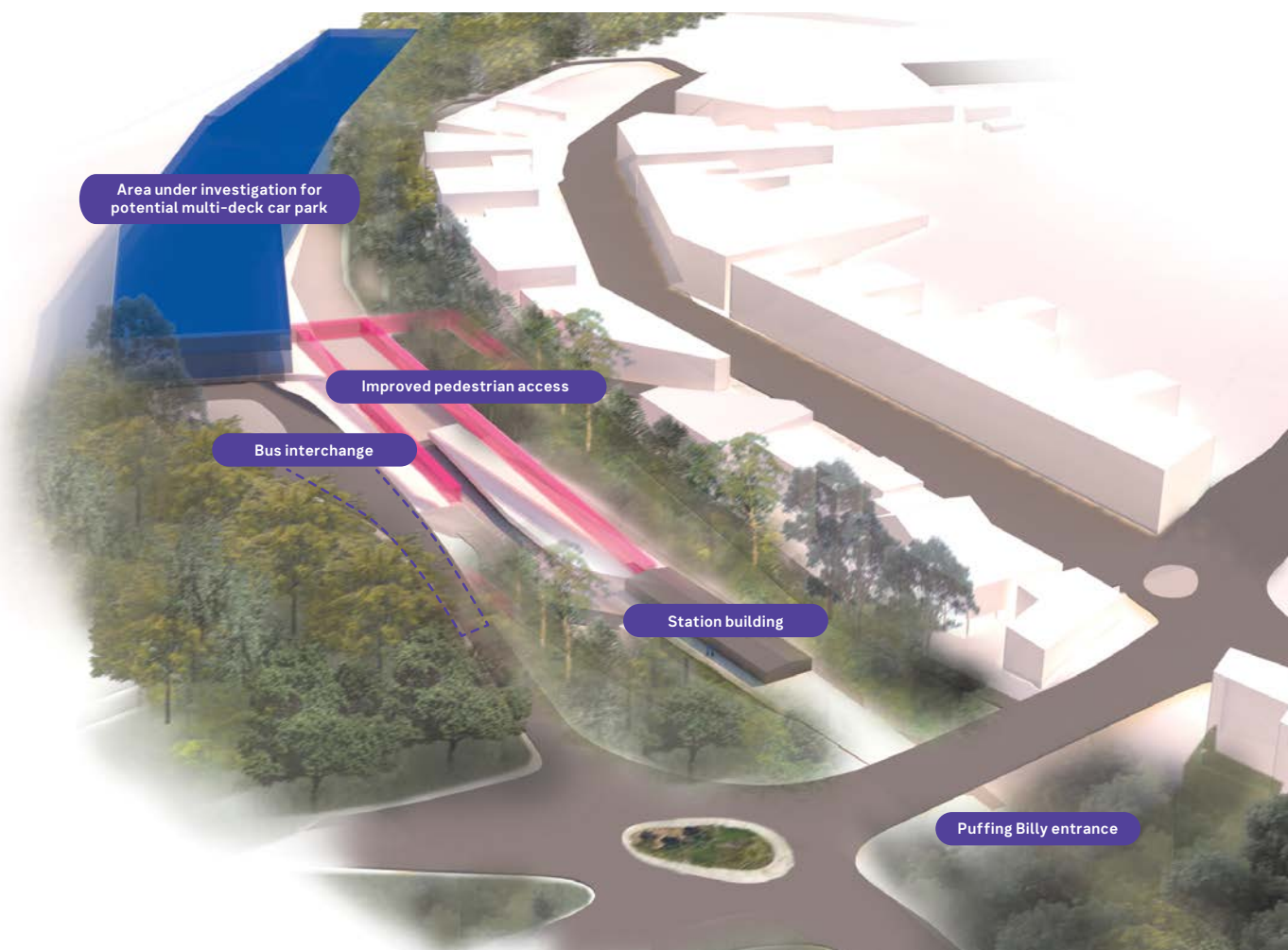


Belgrave Station car park upgrade

We are delivering a car park upgrade at Belgrave Station.

The priorities for the project include:

- a new multi-deck car park
- improving access to the station for people of all abilities
- upgrading the bus interchange
- improving wayfinding through the precinct

This project is part of the Victorian Government's \$60 million commitment to provide more than 2,000 new and upgraded car parking spaces across Victoria.

The process

This is an important project and we need to take time to properly plan.

We are in the early stages of the planning process, building an understanding of the views and needs of community and stakeholders.

In the next few months, we will begin site assessments, environmental and safety investigations to better understand the site conditions. We will also consult with expert engineers, architects and transport stakeholders.

Next year we will develop a concept design and seek feedback from the broader Belgrave community.

Community feedback will help inform the development of a reference design. A reference design is used to apply for permits and to inform detailed design and construction.
